

Guidelines for Anita Ernouf Teacher Scholarship

Alpha Delta Kappa is an International Honorary Sorority for Women Educators dedicated to educational excellence, altruism, and world understanding. For over fifty years, the Alpha Delta chapter, founded in 1971, has had the pleasure of awarding scholarships to deserving high school and college students. This scholarship is given annually in memory of Dr. Anita B. Ernouf—a member of the modern languages faculty at (then) Longwood College from 1960-1985 and a founding member of the Alpha Delta chapter.

To apply for this scholarship, please be aware of the guidelines below:

1. A scholarship of \$1000 shall be given to a deserving student who plans to make teaching a career.
2. Applicants must have been accepted by, or currently enrolled in, a college or university in Virginia.
3. Applicants will graduate, or must have graduated high school from a county represented by the Virginia Alpha Delta chapter membership: Amelia, Charlotte, Cumberland, Nottoway, and Prince Edward.
4. Each applicant must be in the upper quartile of his/her class.
5. An **essay** must be included with the application, answering the following prompt: Why are you are choosing teaching as a career?
6. **Three** letters of recommendation must be included with the application. Recommendations may be written by principals, teachers, and/or guidance counselors.
7. Completed applications for the Anita Ernouf Teacher Scholarship **must be received by March 30, 2024.**
8. Complete application packets must be mailed to the Chair of the Scholarship Committee:

9. All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee. A letter will be sent to the recipient by the committee.
10. Children of Alpha Delta members will not be eligible.
