2022 Charlotte County APVA Scholarship Application

The *Charlotte County Association for the Preservation of Virginia Antiquities* will offer a one-time (non-renewable) scholarship (\$500) to a high school senior graduating in 2022 or to a student enrolled full time in college. Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- Applicant must be a Charlotte County resident,
- Applicant plans to attend college in the fall of 2022, or
- Applicant is currently enrolled full time in college, and
- Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA.

Applicants should submit a typed, one-page essay to the Charlotte County APVA describing the applicant's interest in history/preservation or related fields, and the applicant's college and career plans. Finalists may be invited to an interview with the Charlotte County APVA Scholarship Committee.
